Chinatown	3.4 miles	Bustling neighborhood with shops, cafes, dim sum spots, and teahouses. Can get here by Red Line or Water Taxi.
West Argyle Street Historic District, Little Saigon	6.6 miles	Vietnamese restaurants, bakeries and shops; as well as Chinese, Cambodian, Laotian and Thai businesses along Argyle Street.
Northalsted (formerly "Boystown")	5.3 miles	"Home to one of the largest LGBT communities in the Midwestern U.S., Northalsted is a bustling neighborhood in West Lakeview. It has hosted Chicago's annual Pride Parade since 1971 and has charming coffee shops, cool record stores and trendy boutiques along its tree-lined streets. Known for its comedy clubs and offbeat theaters, the area also draws young, hip crowds to its vibrant cocktail bars and nightclubs."
Fulton River District	1.3 miles	Neighborhood located on the edge of Chicago's downtown, northwest of the Loop. Selection of some of the Chicago's most popular restaurants.
Greektown	2.1 miles	Oopa! Greek cultural district with many traditional Greek dining options. Located on the Near West Side, adjacent to the Loop.

Lakefront Trail, starting at 71st Street in the Jackson Park Highlands neighborhood and running north up to Ardmore Street in the Edgewater Neighborhood	About 0.5 miles to the Riverwalk access point and about 0.4 from the Illinois Street access point	Great for renting Divvy Bikes, walking, running, or viewing the lake!
360 Chicago, Hancock Tower, 875 North Michigan Avenue	0.8 miles	Great view of the city!

Willis Tower Building 233 S Wacker Drive (entrance on Jackson Blvd, south side of building)	1.6 miles	108-story building with enclosed glass balconies that allow Skydeck visitors to gaze down at the streets a mile 1,300 ft below
Tribune Tower Building 435 N. Michigan Avenue	0.3 miles	Chicago historical landmark featuring fragments of famous buildings from around the world in the building's facade
