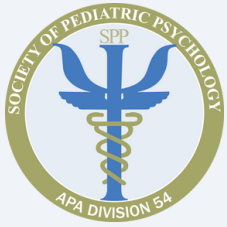

Learning Objectives

- To dedicate a full day to learning about high impact areas of pediatric psychology research produced by SPP research leaders who come from diverse research backgrounds such as assessment, treatment and interventions, clinical outcomes, adherence, and health disparities.
- To provide a forum for discussion of current clinical translational research directions and to consider how research informs clinical practice, service delivery, health equity, and policy decisions.
- To increase attendees' awareness of current advancements in equity, diversity, and inclusion in the field of pediatric psychology and considerations for their own work.
