

Poster/Paper Abstract Submission Guidelines

Poster/Paper Description (1-1.25 CE)

Submissions for paper and poster abstracts must not exceed 300 words (not including authors, affiliations, and title).

Structure. Submissions can be considered for paper presentation only, poster presentation only, or both. All paper and poster submissions must have complete data at the time of submission. Authors must attest that abstract data are novel and are not currently submitted nor under review or published in any other medium that will be published or presented before SPPAC.

Poster Abstract Submissions will be considered for presentation during a 60-minute assigned poster session. Posters will be assigned to sessions within topic groups. During the poster session, presenters are encouraged to engage participants. At least one poster author should be present for the entire poster session to answer questions from participants.

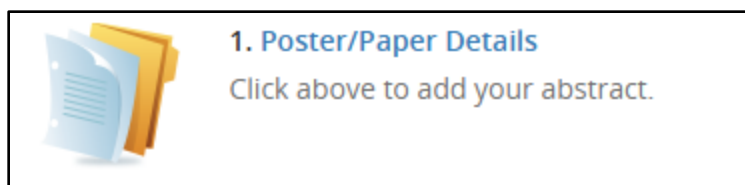
Paper abstract submissions will be considered to participate in a 75-minute session with other papers of similar content organized by the Scientific Program Committee.

Authors. Authors are limited to one first-authored poster/paper abstract submission. Please list author affiliation based on where the work was completed.

POSTER/PAPER ABSTRACT SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Submissions must include:

Title. Session title (80 characters)

TIP: Attendees often decide which posters to view based on their titles. Make sure yours is clear and engaging, with the key words and concepts at the beginning.

For Example:

Instead of:

“Iterative Integration of Pediatric Psychologist into Subspecialty Medical Clinics to Maximize Sustainability and Replicability”

Try:

“Brick By Brick: Building Models of Subspecialty Integration”

1. **Topics.** Select one Primary Topic and one Secondary Topic. You will be able to select up to 3 additional topics if applicable, later in the submission portal. (see [Tags and Topics Guidelines](#)).
2. **Submission Type.** Please Indicate if you would like your proposal to be considered for one of the following.
 - a. **Poster Submission**
 - b. **Paper Submission**
 - c. **Paper and Poster Submission**
3. **Publishing of Abstract.** Please indicate if you agree to have your abstract published in the Journal of Pediatric Psychology Supplemental.
4. **Novel Data Attestation.** Please attest that all data presented are novel and not submitted nor under review or published elsewhere.
5. **Introduction.** Background, Key Objectives.
6. **Methods.** *Sample, procedures, measures, analysis.*
7. **Results.** *Primary findings. All abstracts must include results. Abstracts with pending results will not be accepted.*
8. **Conclusions.** *Implications and Future directions*
